Combine pots, plants, rugs and pillows to create vignettes within a color palette. Pots in unique glacier blue or French blue paired with a blue and cream outdoor rug can make a warm Oklahoma day appear cool. This pale blue container on a brown,

cream, and light blue rug is planted with a shade tropical variety of Peace Lily that features light blue variegation in the leaves.



Containers in blues, cream, or white blend well with this crisp blue and cream floral outdoor rug.

Neutral tones are featured in a beautiful square rug, a perfect companion to the intricate bee collage pillow and glazed terra cotta urn in cognac. Cognac is a new color for containers introduced this year.



A new color, Iced Coffee, was also introduced this year by Campania International and has proven to be a very popular neutral shade.

We have had many requests for red and gold containers; together they can create a sunny, warm Provençal ambiance.



The earthy colors of jade and cocoa combine well in the garden. The soothing tones and simple lines



shown in these containers complement each other. The glaze of the pots gives a sparkle to shady areas, and the coordinating rug adds depth to and a welcoming feel to seating areas.

Torches in polished or verdigris hammered copper cast a soft romantic glow wherever they are placed. The lamp bowl holds enough oil for 8 hours of burn time. Wicks are fiberglass so they never burn away.



Celebrate summer and the 4th of July with a colorful garden flag. From floral watercolor images to traditional stars and stripes, there is a flag for everyone and every occasion, even birthdays!



The gleaming copper hose pot will hold 150' of hose. This is slightly larger than the verdigris brass hose pots. You will enjoy having a hose pot; they are simply wonderful!

JUNE 2010 TO DO LIST

- Mulch 2" deep around woody plants after cleaning underneath. Start several inches out from trunks..
- Patrol for weeds; they rob desired plants of water and nutrients.
- If the hail didn't do it for you, deadhead for long season bloom.
- If the hail also didn't do this for you, some perennials may need to be pruned hard to restart.
- Ditto, pinch back fall blooming Mums, Asters, Monardia.
- Stake tomato plants or buy new ones.
- Hail or not, maintenance trims on wisteria.
- Spring flowering shrubs get pruned now.
